






ACADEMIC PROGRESS RATE (APR) | 2012-16

Last Five Years Academic Progress Rate



COMPLIANCE | CORE FUNCTIONS

Coordinate the university's efforts in MAINTAINING INSTITUTIONAL CONTROL of the athletic department, making appropriate recommendations to the president, athletic director and faculty athletic representative

Develop and implement an NCAA RULES EDUCATION PROGRAM for coaches, studentathletes and both internal and external staff and constituents to athletics in all areas relevant to NCAA legislation

Develop and implement both a MONITORING AND AN AUDIT SYSTEM for coaches, student-athletes, and both internal and external staff and constituents to athletics in all areas relevant to NCAA legislation

ENFORCE NCAA, PAC-12 AND UNIVERSITY RULES in addition to self-reporting secondary violations of NCAA rules and making recommendations for corrective actions as necessary

INTERPRET NCAA AND PAC-12 legislation for coaches, student-athletes, staff, media and other entities both internal and external to the university community



COMPLIANCE EVALUATIVE MEASURES

TOP-DOWN COMMITMENT TO COMPLIANCE

- Key university leadership must be engaged in compliance efforts

SYSTEMS & MONITORING

- Systems must be in place and monitored

RULES EDUCATION

- Adequate education must be provided to all relevant parties

INSTITUTIONAL ENFORCEMENT

- Systems for investigation, self-reporting and correction must be in place when a potential violation has been identified
