

## Status Report: Academic Programs in Development or Review; Institutional Accreditation; Program Accreditations

### ACADEMIC PROGRAMS IN DEVELOPMENT OR REVIEW

Proposals for new academic programs are initiated by faculty in their academic unit and proceed through the following stages:

- Stage 1.** Proposal preparation at the unit and college levels.
- Stage 2.** Review and approval at the unit and college levels.
- Stage 3.** University internal review and approval process. Proposals are reviewed by the 1) Budget and Fiscal Planning Committee, 2) Graduate Council (for new graduate programs only), 3) Faculty Senate Curriculum Council, 4) Faculty Senate Executive Committee, 5) Faculty Senate, 6) Provost, and 7) Board of Trustees.
- Stage 4.** External review and approval process. Proposals are reviewed by the Statewide Provosts Council and approved by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC). Once this review and approval process is complete, the university provides notification of the program to the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU), the university’s accrediting body.

**INSTITUTIONAL ACCREDITATION**

*No changes since Oct. 2022:*

Oregon State University is accredited by the NWCCU, one of seven institutional accreditation agencies in the U.S. recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation. In July 2019, the Board of Commissioners of the NWCCU reaffirmed OSU’s institutional accreditation through 2026. In April 2022 OSU submitted the Mid-Cycle Evaluation Report and hosted a virtual site visit. As part of that process, the Commission requested OSU:

- Submit an Ad Hoc Report with visit spring 2023, addressing Recommendation 1: Spring 2022 Mid-Cycle Review, and Recommendation 2: Spring 2019 Mission Fulfillment and Sustainability.

The following is OSU’s institutional accreditation evaluation schedule, based on the NWCCU’s 2020 Standards for Accreditation and Eligibility Requirements:

- Annual Report – due on August 15 of each year
- Progress Report – due Fall 2020
- Mid-Cycle Evaluation (Year Three Report) – April 25 & 26, 2022
- Ad Hoc Report with site visit – Spring 2023
- Policies, Regulations, and Financial Review (PRFR – Year Six Report) – Spring 2025
- Evaluation of Institutional Effectiveness (EIE – Year Seven Report) with visit –Spring 2026

**PROGRAM ACCREDITATIONS**

In addition to the institutional accreditation, individual academic and administrative programs may hold a specialized or professional accreditation that is evaluated on a regular cycle by the respective accrediting body.
