Dates of Significance

- April 4: First Chamber Committee Deadline

Budget Developments

- **Public University Support Fund**

- Request - \$1.05B
- GRB - \$933M
- Co-Chairs - \$948M

- **Oregon Opportunity Grant**

- Request - \$400M
- GRB - \$300M
- Co-Chairs - \$208.4M

- **OSU Statewides & State Programs**

- GRB - 7.9% increase
- Co-Chairs – 5.4% increase

- **Capital Renewal & Investment Fund**

- Request - \$90M
- GRB - \$200M

Policy Bills

- Semiconductors
 - **SB 4** - \$200M Innovation Fund; \$10M University Innovation Research Fund; Land Use policy
 - **HB 3254** – Establishes Semiconductor & Advanced Manufacturing Talent Sustaining Fund
- University Governance – SB 273
 - Expands board to 12-16 members and membership
 - Requires university designees to be nominated through a consensus process
 - Charge boards with adopting policies on public comment periods, responding to complaints and concerns, membership of presidential search committees, Trustee emails, filling board vacancies, and transparency and self-evaluations
 - Require annual reports to legislative committee regarding implementation of policies
 - HECC to provide regular opportunities for Trustees to engage with other higher education leaders and receive training
