WHEREAS, Michael J. (Mike) Green joined Oregon State University in 2014 and has served as the vice president for Finance and Administration and chief financial officer since 2017, and

WHEREAS, through his stewardship of OSU's financial, administrative and physical resources, he furthered the university's strategic plan and promoted OSU's quality and unique strengths, and

WHEREAS, Mike led the development of the university's ten-year business forecast to better support leadership decisions; established the Treasury Office and the university's Internal Bank to improve OSU's financial management; initiated the university's first enterprise project portfolio management office to advance OSU's most complex, multi-year and strategically important initiatives, and oversaw the establishment of the Corvallis campus police, as well as the transformation of Environmental Health and Safety into an EPA-award winning office, and

WHEREAS, Mike worked tirelessly with the OSU Foundation and others to raise funds and develop the projects to enable OSU to build the Marine Studies Building, the Peavey Forest Science Complex, the Reser Stadium westside renovation, the Patricia Valian Reser Center for the Arts, the PacWave energy testing site, the Regional Class Research Vessel Taani, and the development of the OSU-Cascades Innovation District, and

WHEREAS, Mike's leadership exemplifies and models, at the highest level, the values of Oregon State University. He prioritized developing the capacity of the Division of Finance and Administration to support OSU's mission, including by developing the division's first DEI action plan; establishing a division-wide committee to advance diversity, equity, inclusion and belonging; and launching the DFA Framework for Success program for more informed and transparent decision-making in operational units for the benefit of the whole university, and




