


August Survey – Corvallis Campus

3394 respondents 18.3% completion rate

Fall plans • Desired experience • Anticipated concerns • Resources & Info

Key Findings: Understanding barriers & concerns

- Higher average response to "How are you?"
- Students are juggling responsibilities (work, leadership, care)
- Top concerns reported:
 - Affording tuition and fees (71%)
 - Affording textbooks (65%)
 - Being motivated (53%)
 - Maintaining mental health (54%)
 - Transmitting illness to a relative or friend (50%)
 - Job prospects (47%)
- Desire for outreach (46% of respondents wanted follow-up)



Key Findings: Helping us plan for fall

- Most (73%) planned to be local to Corvallis
- Preferences for instructors: Use Canvas tools & record lectures
- Access to hardware, less access to study space and internet
- Email as preferred mechanism to communicate
- Preference for appointment-based services vs. drop in
- Barrier to resources: 57% unsure of where to go




