WHEREAS, J. Michael Goodwin (Mike) joined the Oregon State University Foundation in 2004 as President and Chief Executive Officer, and

WHEREAS, Mike's 15-years of leadership of the OSU Foundation has been remarkable and transformative, developing the Foundation into one of the premier public university foundations in the country, and

WHEREAS, under his leadership, the university's first capital fundraising campaign, The Campaign for OSU, raised more than \$1.14 billion from 106,000 donors, and

WHEREAS, the impact of this philanthropy has served thousands of students who have benefitted from the more than \$300 million raised for scholarships and fellowships since Mike's arrival; faculty whose teaching, research, scholarship, and outreach and engagement work flourishes as a result of the 103 endowed positions donors have created; and members of the OSU community who daily enjoy more than 30 new or significantly renovated facilities in Corvallis, Bend, and Newport made possible by philanthropic investments over the last 15 years, and

WHEREAS, Mike has served as a dedicated partner to Oregon State University by advancing programs and initiatives that support the university's strategic vision and mission, and

WHEREAS, through his leadership of the OSU Foundation, his engagement as a respected Oregonian, and his service as the chair of CASE - the Council for the Advancement and Support of Education, Mike has served as a tireless and effective advocate for the value of public higher education in Oregon and beyond, and for increased access to Oregon State University's educational opportunities to a more diverse population, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the members of the Board of Trustees of Oregon State University, hereby extend to Mike Goodwin our gratitude and appreciation for his faithful and outstanding service to the University; our congratulations on his well-earned retirement; and our best wishes to him and his wife, Sheila, for continued happiness and good health.
